Secretary's report:

Treasurer's report:

Sue Bolen, Sr Director, CT/RI T4 American Red Cross addressed the club regarding the ARC Home Fire Safety Program. This is a continuing, nation wide, multi-year effort to educate the public about home fire safety and to provide (install) 10yr smoke detectors in residences at no cost to the residents or owners. The program has been credited with saving numerous lives across the country. Sue's presentation included a review of home fire safety procedures and an offer to install smoke detectors for TCARC members or their friends or neighbors.

Old Business:

- 1. 2019 Museum Ship on the Air: Tim provided a wrap up of the 2019 Museum Ships operation at the Nautilus museum. One station was locater on the pier this year, but other activities on the pier interfered with its use. Three other stations were set up in the museum's parking lot. 675 contacts were logged this tear and Harry, N1FAM is issuing QSLs as they are requested. Next year, we will probably forgo the station on the pier.
- 2. Field day 2019: Field Day will be held at the Holdrige Pavilion at the Ledyard Fair Grounds. Field Day antennas were discussed. Further FD planning will be done during the next Saturday AM breakfast meeting. A motion was made and seconded to provide Josh, KOJEB with \$!00 to purchase food and fuel for Field Day (W1FWE/K1EV). Tim, KC1TWR will serve as Field Day Safety Officer, Josh will be Logistics

Coordinator. FD setup will start at 0900, June 22, with on the air operation running from 1400 until 1400, June 23.

3. Sandy Point operation: Planning continued for the Sandy Point Island operation in late July. Sandy Point Island has been registered with the Islands on the Air.

New Business

- 1. Annual dues are due. All members are requested to complete new membership applications, either paper or online at the club website, as we are assembling a new member database. Dues for 2019-20 year will be \$10.
- 2. The annual Light Houses on the Air activity (August 3 this year) was briefly discussed as a possible event for a future year.

- 4. The new slate of club officers, elected at the May meeting, were installed and will assume their duties at the conclusion of this, the June meeting. All members present expressed their thanks to Tim, KC1TWR for his hard work and leadership over the past three years.
